The Strabane Ambush was a British Special Air Service ambush against a three man Provisional Irish Republican Army unit. All three members of the PIRA unit were killed in the ambush. At the time it was the most successful SAS operation against the IRA, until the Loughgall ambush two years later in 1987 in which eight IRA Volunteers were killed.
